Notice is hereby given that the April General Municipal Election will be held in the County of Cass on Tuesday, April 8, 2008 as certified to this office by the participating entities of Cass County. The ballot for the election shall be in substantially the following form:

**CASS COUNTY
OUT OF STATE USE TAX
PROPOSITION**

Shall the County of Cass impose a local use tax on out of state purchases to eliminate the current sales tax advantage that non Missouri vendors have over Missouri vendors at the same rate as the total local sales tax rate, currently one and one fourth percent (1¼%), provided that if the local sales tax rate is reduced or raised by voter approval, the local use tax rate shall also be reduced or raised by the same action? A use tax return shall not be required to be filed by persons whose purchase from out of state vendors do not in total exceed two thousand dollars in any calendar year. All receipts from this tax shall be divided equally between Law Enforcement, General County, and Road and Bridge uses.
