**PROPOSITION 2**

Shall the Board of Education of the Holden R-III School District, Missouri borrow money in the amount of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) for the purpose of providing funds to complete roof repairs and replacement, structural repairs, electrical system upgrades for technology equipment, heating, ventilation and air conditioning improvements for energy efficiency, restructuring of building entrance for safety and security and parking lot resurfacing improvements to the high school and middle school; construction, equipping and furnishing of a physical education/athletic practice room/locker room building; to complete other remodeling and repair improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue bonds, a portion of which may include Qualified School Construction Bonds and Qualified Zone Academy Bonds in an amount not to exceed the allocation from the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, for the payment thereof resulting in an estimated increase to the debt service property tax levy of \$0.27 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the school district is estimated to increase from \$0.70 to \$0.97 per one hundred dollars assessed valuation of real and personal property.
