

Minutes of August 12, 2011

The Cass County Commission convened on August 12, 2011 at 9:00 A.M. for the 5th day of the July term, with members present as follows:

County Clerk Janet Burlingame opened the Commission meeting at 9:00am and appointed Commissioner Brian Baker as Acting Presiding Commissioner pursuant to RSMo. 49.070.

Commissioner Baker opened the *Public Hearing* to discuss the re-districting of the County Commission Districts.

Acting Presiding Commissioner Baker asked at this time if there was any Public Comment.

Public Comment –

Kirk Powell, Pleasant Hill Times-What is the population of Cass County?

Brian Baker- According to the 2010 Census it is 99,478.

Kirk Powell-What is the difference between District 1 and District 2 now?

Brian Baker- DISTRICT #2; Includes all of the following:

Starting at County Line Road South on Emerald View Drive continue South on Wheeler Rd, West on 251st Street, then North on South Harper Rd, then West & North following Peculiar City Limits, then West on State Route YY Hwy even with 203rd Street, then continue West on 203rd Street to County Line Road, then North on South Martin Road which becomes Pickering Rd, then West on 203rd Street Westerly to State Route D Hwy, to West 203rd Street to State Line Road then North to County Line Rd.

DISTRICT #1;Includes all other areas in Cass County not included in the new District 2.

Kirk Powell-What is the percentage of the Districts?

Brian Baker and Bill Cook-49% District 1 and 51% District 2- Has to stay within 10%.

Kirk Powell-So population for District 1 would be 46,252 and District 2 would be 53,226.

Brian, Bill and Janet- Yes

County Clerk Janet Burlingame opened the Commission meeting at 9:30am and appointed Commissioner Brian Baker as Acting Presiding Commissioner pursuant to RSMo. 49.070.
