Molendorp: Cass County Senior Citizen Property Tax Credit open enrollment dates announced for new applicants

March 2, 2026 (Harrisonville) Collector of Revenue Chris Molendorp has announced the 2026 open enrollment dates for new applicants for senior homesteaders to enroll in the Cass County Senior Citizens Property Tax Credit. Open enrollment will start April 13th and end July 3rd. Enrollment hours are from 9AM to 3PM at Mill-Walk Mall, 2725 Cantrell Road, Harrisonville.

“Just like Medicare enrollment, our office has a specific period of time when seniors who are new to the tax credit program can enroll,” said Chris Molendorp, Cass County Collector of Revenue.

The tax credit was authorized by Missouri Senate Bill 190 in 2023 and implemented in 2024, with nearly 10,000 senior Cass County households enrolling. The program now boasts nearly 11,000 senior households.

The open enrollment procedure is for new applicants only. Those senior homeowners who are new to Cass County, and those homeowners who turn 62 in 2026, still must apply in person initially. Seniors will be asked to bring the following: A government issued photo identification; a utility bill showing the homesteader’s service address, OR a current Cass County Voter ID card; and if the home is in trust or Limited Liability Company (LLC), a copy of the trust or the LLC’s operating agreement.
